### Genus Designer Release Notes - December 2015

### Products

Genus Designer 2014 SP5 for SolidWorks (64 bit)

#### System Requirements

Genus Designer 64 bit has been created to run with SolidWorks 2012, 2013, 2014 or 2015 64 bit. Any machine correctly configured to run SolidWorks can run the Designer.

In addition it requires:

Microsoft Visio 2010 64 bit (if using the Knowledge Editor)
Microsoft Access or SqlServer
 (if creating or updating databases)
Microsoft Word 64 bit (if generating Word Reports)
Microsoft Excel 64 bit (if generating Excel Reports)

#### License Agreement

Microsoft Visio 2010 Standard Edition is provided as an optional prerequisite on the Designer installation DVD. Installing it implies acceptance of the Microsoft Visio End User License Agreement. A copy of this agreement can be found in the root directory of the DVD.

Installing Genus Designer 2014 requires acceptance of the Genus Designer Software License Agreement.

# Updating

If updating from an earlier version, uninstall that version using Add/Remove programs in the Windows Control Panel. When upgrading a major release (e.g. 2013 to 2014), you will not need a new serial number but you will need to reactivate.

Updating within a major version does not require an uninstall.

## Installing

Insert the Genus Designer 2014 install DVD and autorun or double click on the Designer setup executable.

The Designer installation process will ask for a 16 Character Serial number provided by your Genus Designer reseller. This number will allow the installation process to continue and give you 30 days to activate the product.

### Startup

To load Genus Designer as a SolidWorks add-in:

- Select the SolidWorks Tools->Add-ins menu to bring up the Add-ins dialog.
- Check the box to the left of the Designer Generator or the Designer Explorer to load the add-in.
- 3. If you want it to start up each time SolidWorks is started, check the box to the right.
- 4. Click the [ OK ] button.

If the product you wish to load has not been activated, the Designer License Activation dialog will appear.

#### Trial Period

The Serial Number provided by your reseller initiates a 30 day trial period. During this period, the product may be used with no activation. Click [Continue] to use the product (once for each add-in checked). Once the trial period has expired, a product activation is necessary to continue to use this product.

## Requesting Product Activation

To activate this product:

- Attempt to load your Genus Designer product (see Startup).
- 2. The Designer License Activation Dialog is displayed.
- 3. Copy the Request Code that is generated.
- 4. Go to the activations page of the Genus Software website:

www.genussoftware.com/activation.html

5. Follow the instructions on this page to request a Product Activation. It will be emailed to you.

## Note:

Once you have sent in a Request Code, do not select [ Reset Code ]. (Reset Code is only used if there is a problem with the key that has been sent to you)

Once you have you Product Activation license (.licx) file, follow the instructions in Installing a License (below).

### Installing a License

After you have received your Product Activation license file:

- 1. Copy it to your desktop (or other convenient place)
- 2. Attempt to load your Genus product (see Startup, above).
- 3. At the Designer License Activation dialog, click the [Install] button.
- 4. Browse to the Product Activation license file location and click open.
- Your application will now start. The Product Activation license file is no longer needed and may be deleted.

# Using Genus Designer

- 1. Load the Genus Designer Add-in
- 2. Select Help->Genus Designer Help menu.
- 3. Follow the instructions.

### Known Issues

Genus Designer 2014 64 bit only runs within SolidWorks 64 bit on a Microsoft Windows 64 bit operating system.

SolidWorks 2014 will not run on Windows XP.
